FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

In the month of May, we celebrate the Canaan Sheepfold Ministry, which was conceived and birthed over forty years ago by Pastor Emeritus Gus Roman. The Canaan Sheepfold Ministry, i.e. Small groups or cell groups, consists of mini-Canaan communities that provide fellowship and discipleship in a setting of shared lives, common goals, and a mutual commitment to Christian growth.

The Sheepfold Ministry is composed of twelve (12) tribes replicating the Tribal System of Israel **Genesis 35:22-26; 49:28**. Additionally, the Sheepfold Ministry is modeled after the method employed by Jesus for his most intimate fellowship, vision casting and teaching of his disciples. **Mark 2:1; 7:14-27; 9:33; 10:2-12; Matthew 13:36**.

The Sheepfold Ministry helps us create a closer, more connected community.

Each tribe is led by a Deacon and a lay person (Tribe Leader), who work together to support our members. These Tribes do more than organize our church—they bring people together. Members meet regularly and are encouraged to participate in Bible Study and church activities and to grow their faith. Ideally, every disciple at Canaan would be actively involved in a tribe because:

- Tribes provide a fertile environment for Bible Study.
- Tribes are incubators for worship in spirit and in truth.
- Tribes focus on the importance of prayer for wisdom and comfort.
- Tribes serve as a conduit for evangelism for family and friends.
- Tribes illuminate, reveal, and nurture Spiritual Gifts for leading edge ministry that gives purpose to the believer and advances the Kingdom.
- Tribes introduce personal and mutual accountability among Canaan disciples.

BRO. MARK TRENT'S INITIAL SERMON



On Saturday, May 17, 2025, at 10:00am, Canaanite, Bro. Mark Trent will preach his Initial Sermon. Bro. Trent has been a longtime dedicated servant at Canaan. He has the spiritual gifts of teaching, exhortation, and service. During his tenure at Canaan, he has served in

several ministries, including Christian Education, the Sheepfold Ministry, the Men of Canaan, the Veterans' Ministry, and the Prison Ministry.

An "Initial Sermon" refers to the first sermon delivered by a person who believes that they are called by God to serve in a specific role in the church and the Kingdom at large. These roles can include a Preacher, an Evangelist, a Chaplain, etc. The Initial Sermon also provides an opportunity for the local church's Pastor, leaders, and members to publicly affirm a person's calling after extensively experiencing their spiritual gifts, dedication, maturity, and character.

Congregational affirmation includes the issuance of a Ministry License. This credential authorizes the person to represent the local church in performing specific functions within the church and throughout the Body of Christ.

Many Baptist churches, including Canaan:

- Bestow the title of "Minister" on those who receive a Ministry License.
- Do not permit a licensed minister to perform a wedding ceremony, a burial committal, or administer Holy Communion without the presence of an ordained clergy person.
- Reserve the title of "Reverend" for those individuals who have received Ministry Ordination.

Please begin praying for Bro. Trent and mark your calendars to ensure your attendance as we mark this significant moment in the life of our brother and of Canaan.
