WHAT IS THE CHURCH?

- The word translated *church* in the New Testament is from the Greek word *ekklesia*, which means an assembly or congregation.
- Church does not refer to a building, but church refers to people.
- In the New Testament, the church generally refers to believers, Jews or Gentiles, who have placed their faith in Jesus Christ and received the Holy Spirit following Pentecost in Acts 2.
- Church refers to a local assembly, such as the church in Thessalonica (Thessalonians 1:1) or Canaan Baptist Church.
- Church also refers to the universal church of all believers in Jesus Christ in all ages everywhere.

WHAT DIFFERENCE DOES CANAAN MAKE IN THE WORLD?

- Believers are the salt and the light of the world. (Matthew 5:13-16)
- Believers may be the only Jesus the world sees. (Romans 8:29)
- Humans are hungry for God. (John 6:35)
- Humans desire fellowship and love. (Acts 2:43-47)
- The world is dark and evil, and should be drawn to the church. (John 3:19-20)
- The world should be jealous of Christians. (John 17:14)
