## From the Pastor's Desk

## Thanks Living

## 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

"Rejoice evermore. Pray without ceasing. In everything give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you."

Family, as we enter this season, my heart is drawn not just to Thanksgiving—but to Thanks Living.

In Paul's first letter to the church at Thessalonica—a bustling city in ancient Macedonia (modern-day Greece) and a major hub on the Roman trade route—he writes to a young congregation born in hardship. This church, founded during Paul's second missionary journey (Acts 17, around 50–54 A.D.), was facing persecution, false teaching, and social pressure. Yet, instead of retreating, Paul encourages them to stand firm in joy, prayer, and gratitude.

Many of us today can relate. Some are navigating economic uncertainty, family tension, health struggles, grief over loved ones, or even ministry weariness. Paul's timeless words remind us that the Christian life is not about feeling thankful once a year—it's about living thankfully every day.

# Here is Paul's **3-ingredient recipe** for Thanks Living:

## Rejoice Evermore (v.16)

Rejoicing was the heartbeat of early Christianity—it baffled unbelievers and bound the church together. True rejoicing isn't about happiness; it's about holiness.

Happiness depends on what happens, but joy depends on choice. Even when broke, lonely, or sick, we can still choose joy.

**Remember:** Joy is a choice, and the choice is to rejoice! (Philippians 4:4 – "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice.")

## **Pray Without Ceasing (v.17)**

D.L. Moody once said, "God is not bothered by our constant coming and asking. The way to trouble God is not to come at all." Prayer is the ongoing conversation of a grateful heart. It's how we talk and listen to God.

Philadelphia Eagles Quarterback Jalen Hurts has an audio receiver in his helmet to receive instructions from his coaches. Believers must learn how to listen to the right voice—the Spirit's voice guiding us through every play of life. Don't just talk to God—tune in to Him.

## In Every Thing Give Thanks (v.18)

The Greek word *eucharisteo* (from which we get "Eucharist") means "to give thanks." Paul doesn't say give thanks *for* everything, but *in* everything. Gratitude is not denial— it is declaration. It says, "God is good, no matter what I'm going through."

Our thanksgiving should be both **authentic** and **automatic**—flowing from a heart that recognizes God's faithfulness.

- Thank God for what He has done.
- Thank God for what He is doing.
- Thank God for what He will do.

This is the will of God for us—not just to give thanks, but to live thanks.

So, as we journey together, may we be believers who model Thanks Living—rejoicing always, praying continually, and giving thanks in all things.

Because when we live in gratitude, we don't just remember what God has done—we reveal Who He is.
