Objectives

- The young ladies will glean from the lives of the young ladies in the Bible to develop self-respect, awareness and value.
- Participants will identify how the events in the Word of God can take place today and develop their Christian character through the lessons and discussions.
- Ladies will learn the art of jewelry making and gain a respect for women who use this craft to earn their living.
- Through this project young ladies will gain empathy for others and learn about Christian benevolence through this advocacy project to end gender-based violence.
